- DermaClose RC is a device which stretches the skin around open wounds (external tissue
- 2 It pulls the two edges of a wound together and holds them in place (provides continuous tension)
- The wound can be sealed (the edges of the wound are brought close enough for final suturing)
- reduces the area of the wound very quickly; reduces the lengths of scars significantly; helps treat moderate-to-large acute and chronic wounds


