Number worksheet 7: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Point to the figure 7 on the worksheet and practise saying the number with your child (Seven). Ask the child to say the names of the different toys. Tell the child that he/she needs to count the toys in each box and tick the box that has seven items each time. Help him/her to count and tick.
