Number worksheet 19: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Play the audio clip for your child to listen and point to the numbers 91 to 100 on the unicorns. Then practise saying the numbers together, with and without the audio. The child then traces the digits of each number either with his/her finger or a pencil. Encourage him/her to say the numbers at the same time. Then the child can colour the pictures. Ask, e.g. What colour is 99? or point to a unicorn. Encourage the child to reply with the number, e.g. 99 is purple.
