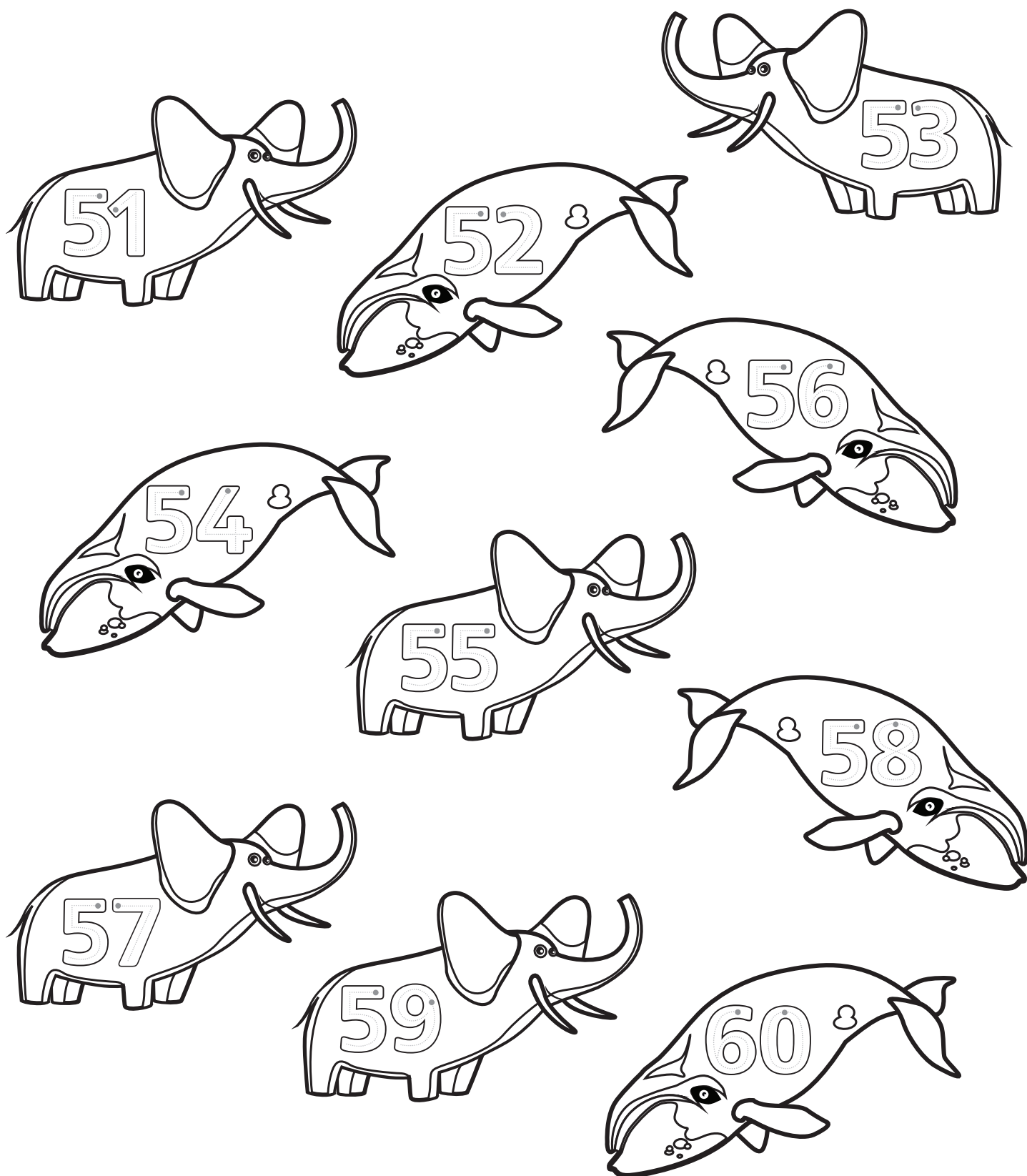


► Point and say the numbers. Then trace and colour.



Number worksheet 15: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Play the audio clip for your child to listen and point to the numbers 51 to 60 on the animals. Then practise saying the numbers together, with and without the audio. The child then traces the numbers, either with his/her finger or with a pencil. Encourage him/her to say the numbers at the same time. Point to the elephants and help the child to say the odd numbers only. Repeat for the whales. Then the child can colour the pictures. Ask, e.g. What colour is 53? or point to an animal. Encourage the child to reply with the number, e.g. 53 is green.
