Unit 9 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

- Polly: Let's dance!
- Others: Great idea, Polly!
- Leo: I'm tired! Let's sit down.
- Gina: Ice cream, mmm!
- Polly: Look ... no money.
- Mike: Oh dear.
- Gina: Look at that!
- Polly: Oh dear. Our party. What a mess!
- Leo: Let's tidy up.
- Others: Great idea, Leo.
- Mike: Phew. It's a lot of work!
- Gina: There! It looks great again.
- Vendor: Nice work, everyone! Here's ice cream for you!
- All: Oh, thank you!

Cut out the eight pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to name other things in the pictures, too, e.g. shoes, hat, belt, shirt, boots, badge, ice cream). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Pupil's Book pages 76 and 77.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (The animals are at a fancy dress party in the park. They want some ice cream, but they haven't got any money. Then they notice how messy the park is and they tidy up. The ice cream vendor gives them free ice creams as a reward.). The child can then colour the pictures.
