Unit 7 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Cut out the eight pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names. Encourage him/her to name the different foods in the story (soup, sausages, chips, apples, cakes, ice cream). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Pupil's Book pages 60 and 61.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (The animals all have their favourite food. Leo eats Polly's soup, most of Gina's sausages and chips, and leaves hardly any apple for Mike. Then he is too full to eat dessert (cake and ice cream).). The child can then colour the pictures.
